Safety Tips for Bicyclists

Each year in California, more than 100 people are killed and hundreds of thousands more are injured in bicycle collisions. Some bicycle related crashes are connected to the bicyclist's behavior, while others are due to the motorist's lack of attention. All bicycle riders do have to follow the same laws as Motorist. These rules and regulations can be easily accessed in the California Driver Handbook. The California Vehicle Code (VC) contains specific laws pertaining to bicycle riders to ensure their and others safety. Did you know that it is against the law to operate a bicycle while under the influence of an alcoholic beverage or drugs? (CVC 21200.5). You can be convicted with a fine up to \$250 dollars, also if you're under 21 but over 13years of age you can get your driving privilege will be suspended or delayed for one year once you are eligible to drive.

Maintain control of your bicycle and protect yourself

There are many things you can do to control your bicycle, even in an emergency. First ensure that your bicycle is properly adjusted to fit you. A bicycle shop can help you choose the correct size for your comfort. It is important to ensure your bicycle is in good working order by inspecting it regularly. By law, bicycle riders under 18 years of age must wear a bicycle helmet while riding on the public road (CVC §21212). Bicyclist should ride far enough away from parked vehicles in public or private areas to avoid being hit by an opening door. Ride carefully around vehicles waiting at stop signs, in driveways, or parking spaces they can suddenly pull out in front of you. Even if you obey all traffic laws, there is always a risk of being hit a by a motorist who is not obeying the law, or simply does not see you. Be visible and be alert and be prepared to stop or take evasive action.
